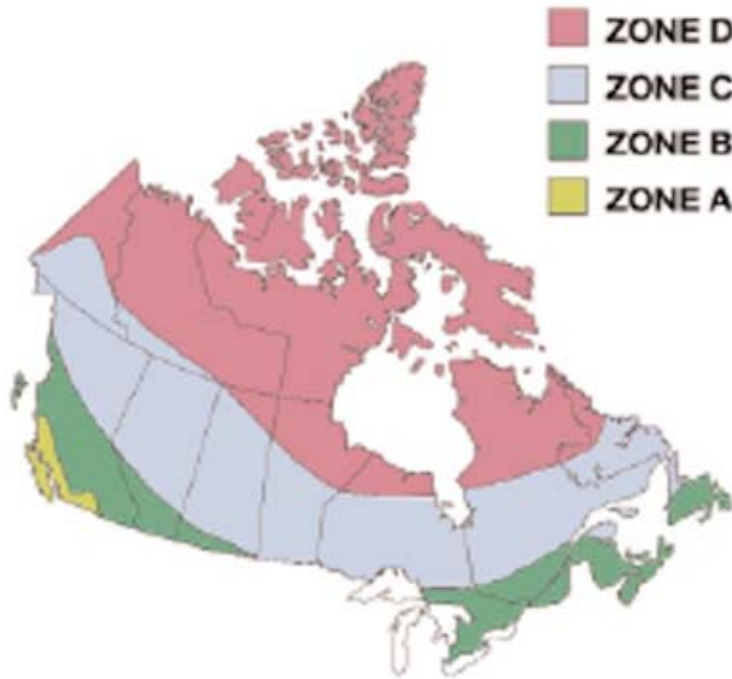


Thermal Performance Criteria for Canada



The Canadian initiative for fenestration products differs from the U.S. program. Canada has its own set of climate zones with specific qualifying levels set for each zone. There are 4 zones ranging from Zone A (mildest) to Zone D (coldest). Zone boundaries were set using Heating Degree Day (HDD) values. The more zones a product qualifies for, the more energy efficient it is.

Zone	Maximum U-Value (Metric)	Maximum U-Value (Imperial)
A	2.00	0.35
B	1.80	0.32
C	1.60	0.28
D	1.40	0.25
